Rainbow Flex -- Surgical Bed for Neonates

1. World's first surgical table designed just for neonatal and newborn surgeries.
 - a. First bed to allow total control of the infant position in three dimensions plus rotation
 - b. First bed to allow access to the infant on all four sides while still maintaining heat to keep them warm
 - c. First bed to allow real-time C-Arm imaging so that surgeons can check line placement and repairs without the need to move the infant.

2. Designed over the past year working directly with staff at Rainbow Babies & Children's Hospital including:
 - a. Surgeons
 - b. Anesthesiologists
 - c. Eye surgeons
 - d. Scrub nurses
 - e. Neonatologists
 - f. Neurosurgeons
 - g. Respiratory therapists

3. A true testament to dedicated medical professionals who see beyond what is available today and can create a vision for the future. Dr. Edward Barksdale, chief of pediatric surgery, and Ann Reitenbach, nurse manager, helped fuel the vision.

4. The bed is named in honor of the team at Rainbow and is thus called the Rainbow Flex.
