## Electromyography Program

### **Accurate results available on the day of the test**

University Hospitals Neurological Institute provides electromyography (EMG) testing to patients with suspected neuromuscular disorders, including entrapment neuropathies, radiculopathies, peripheral neuropathies, motor neuron disease, and myasthenia gravis.

The testing is offered at six convenient EMG labs (see box on back), all equipped with brand new, state-of-the-art Medtronic machines, and staffed by board-certified electromyographers.

*Same-day service is available for referring physicians. A finalized report is faxed to the referring doctor on the day of the study. A copy of the results is also sent by mail.*

The EMG Lab employs only registered nerve conduction study technologists, certified by the American Association of Electrodiagnostic Technologists National Examination Committee.

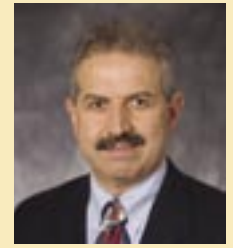
This certification ensures the most highly skilled technicians, an important part of any EMG study. The Neurological Institute requires all its nerve conduction technologists to sit for this examination.

#### Carefully designed tests yield more thorough results

All patients are examined by our EMG doctor prior to testing. This allows us to determine whether there is additional data we can design into the test to yield even more information. We then report the thorough data to the referring physician.

A finalized report is faxed to the referring doctor on the day of the study. A copy of the results is also sent by mail.

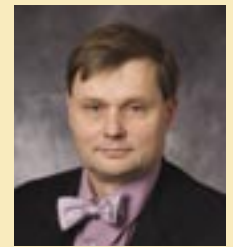
