



## **Bariatric Surgery Program**

Dear Prospective Bariatric Surgery Patient,

In order for us to properly evaluate you and your health, several tests will need to be completed prior to having Bariatric surgery. You may have recently had some of this testing completed through your primary care physician. It would be beneficial if you could bring copies of any listed test results or information with you to your initial appointment:

- Your primary care physician's full name, address, phone and fax numbers
- **Copies of your medical records documenting supervised weight loss attempts for the past 2 years**
- If you see a pulmonologist (lung doctor) on a regular basis, any/all pulmonary function tests dated within the last 6 months
- Copies of labs **if you have had any blood work dated within 6 months**, including CBC, chemistry, kidney and liver profile, endocrine profile (T<sub>3</sub>, T<sub>4</sub>, TSH), lipid levels, iron and ferritin levels, folate, vitamin D and B12 levels
- Copy of a Colonoscopy and/or EGD operative report within the last 5-10 years (all patients will be required to have a screening colonoscopy, if 50 years old and older).
- A list of all your current medications with the dosages
- Copy of a sleep study if you have been tested for sleep apnea

For Women:

- Copy of your most recent pap test dated within last 12 months
- Copy of your most recent mammogram if you are 40 years old or older, or have had a mammogram in the past

**Remember, it is important that we obtain this information prior to your surgery**
