

University Hospitals Case Medical Center Doctors Author Book on Neurosurgery

Nicholas C. Bambakidis, M.D., Director of the Cerebrovascular Center, and Cliff A. Megerian, M.D., Vice Chairman of Otolaryngology-HNS, both of University Hospitals Case Medical Center, have co-authored a book with Robert E. Spetzler, M.D., Chairman of Neurological Surgery at the University of Arizona, called *Surgery of the Cerebellopontine Angle*.

It is a single volume text which is designed to provide a detailed exposition of the treatment options regarding lesions occurring in this region of the skull base. The inclusion of an interactive atlas on DVD complements the text and makes unnecessary the need for multiple reference sources, according to the publisher.

Dr. Bambakidis, a member of the Neurological Institute at University Hospitals Case Medical Center, also is an associate professor at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine. He completed his residency in neurological surgery at University Hospitals Case Medical Center and MetroHealth Medical Center. He completed fellowship training with Dr. Spetzler and Dr. Volker Sonntag at the Barrow Neurological Institute.

Dr. Megerian holds the Richard and Patricia Pogue Endowed Chair in Auditory Surgery at University Hospitals Case Medical Center and Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine.

Dr. Spetzler, Director of the Barrow Neurological Institute in Phoenix, was formerly an associate professor of neurosurgery at Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine.
