### Full Application Overview

Below is the list of sections you will be asked to fill out in your online application. To access and submit your online application, please log in to

- 1. Stage of Development**
- 2. Therapeutic Modality**
- 3. Project Title**
- 4. Abstract (250 Words Maximum)**  
Include a summary of the research plan including goal, hypothesis and specific aim(s); clinical justification, impact and potential commercial opportunity (if known) and highlight aspects which are novel and innovative.
- 5. Project Description (Two-Page Maximum Including Figures; Uploaded as a PDF)**
- 6. Innovation (250 Words Maximum)**  
Position the project within current medical practice and/or scientific literature to highlight what is novel and innovative.
- 7. Impact (250 Words Maximum)**  
Describe the potential clinical impact, medical impact and/or commercial opportunity of the research project. If applicable or known, state the specific embodiment or "Product".
- 8. Intellectual Property Summary (250 Words Maximum)**  
Identify what, if any, IP protection surrounds your proposed project work. Include relevant issued patents or published patent applications.
- 9. Key Data**  
Upload no more than one page of key data that supports your proposal. You're encouraged to show data that supports your choice of target and validates your intervention strategy.
- 10. References**  
Upload no more than one page of references (One-Page PDF Only)
- 11. Biographical Sketch**  
Upload a Biographical Sketch in NIH format (OMB No. 0925-0001/0002 Rev. 10/15) for the PI.
- 12. Co-Investigators**  
Upload a Biographical Sketch in NIH format for each co-investigator involved with the project.
- 13. Additional Documents**  
Upload any additional letters or documents that may be relevant, such as MCAT scores.
