Duties of the *Cons / XXX* Service Fellow:

- 1) Carries and responds to consult service pager
- 2) Gain exposure to subspecialty clinics at the ICC (report to ICC daily at 8:30am except Mondays at 9:00am)
- 3) Perform consult service requests in a timely manner with consult attending supervision
- 4) Triage outside referral calls in consultation with SCC Director, Dr. Egler and/or R2 attending
- 5) Assist NP/Inpatient team with procedures for both R2 / SCC patients (when needed)
- 6) Answer R2 service pager in the afternoon on days when both R2 attending and fellow have same SCC clinic.
- 7) Mentor Pediatric Resident / medical students on PHO elective rotations
- 8) Consult fellows are expected to spend one clinic day during the week in an assigned subspecialty clinic for 1/2 day. This is designed to allow focused clinical exposure to various subspecialty clinics. For example, Consult/BMT means that on Tuesday of the assigned week, the consult fellow is expected to see BMT patients on Tuesday ICC clinic with Dr. Cooke and Linda Cabral for 1/2 day; Consult/CNS means that on Wednesday morning of the assigned week, the consult fellow will see brain tumor patients with Dr. Stearns and Kelly Laschinger in the morning.
